Wal-Mart is providing the in-store gathering area and wrapping supplies; McDonalds will provide lunch for the children. \$100 per child is needed; the total collected will determine how many we can help. All funds go entirely to gift purchasing for the child. Last year 40 delighted children were able to participate.
